



## Office Consolidation Info Hub

- 📌 This multi-phase project is currently impacting several Victoria offices. Planning is underway - check back regularly for updates and resources.

In February, Shannon Salter, Head of the BC Public Service, announced a government-wide initiative to [consolidate office space](#) across ministries. This work is being led by the Ministry of Citizens' Services and aims to make better use of government office space in Victoria and beyond.

The Justice Sector will take part in this initiative through a phased consolidation project over the next several years.

### Why This Is Happening

The goal is to:

- Reduce underutilized office space
- Create flexible, drop-in workspaces organized by geography, not by ministry or branch
- Support more efficient and modern ways of working in alignment with flexible work policies

### Current Stage – Planning (Phase 1)

We are currently in the planning phase for the Justice Sector. This includes:

- Gathering information about unique branch and program needs
- Preparing for upcoming moves by coordinating with Facilities Governance Committee representatives

This foundational work will guide how and when teams transition into shared spaces.

### What's Next

#### Phase 2: PSSG Moves to 620 Superior Street

Five Public Safety and Solicitor General (PSSG) offices will relocate to a shared location at 620 Superior Street.

**Note:** This does not include Community Corrections or Coroners' field offices.

### Phase 3: AG Moves to Three Central Sites

Attorney General (AG) offices currently spread across 12 buildings will be consolidated into:

- 1001 Douglas Street (9th floor)
- 1175 Douglas Street
- 711 Broughton Street

**Note:** This does not include Courthouses or Public Guardian & Trustee.

Timelines for these phases are still being finalized. Moves will happen in stages based on lease expiries, operational requirements, and coordination with other ministries.

#### ✔ What You Can Do Now

- [Review your telework agreement](#) to make sure it reflects your current work situation. Having accurate, up-to-date information will help support planning and space allocation.
- Start organizing workspaces by clearing clutter, surplusing unneeded furniture, and managing paper records.

**Note:** You must work in-office 4 days a week to have a dedicated workspace.
