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RoadSafetyBC Victoria Office Move



RoadSafetyBC Victoria will be moving to [620 Superior Street](#) in September. Here's what you need to know.

What's happening

RoadSafetyBC Victoria is moving from 940 Blanshard Street to 620 Superior Street in September. The move will take place in stages beginning September 17, with staff transitioning into the new workspace starting the week of September 28.

Why it's happening

RoadSafetyBC Victoria is one of five Public Safety and Solicitor General offices moving to a shared location at 620 Superior Street. The move is part of a government-wide office consolidation initiative led by the Ministry of Citizens' Services to create more flexible, collaborative workspaces and make better use of government office space.

When it's happening

Date	What's happening
September 10	Meeting with resident workers to discuss the transition to the new workspace.
September 17	Packing deadline — end of day. Last working day at 940 Blanshard.
September 18–25	Staff work from home or arrange an alternate work site.
September 21–23	Moving activities, including packed boxes, equipment and furniture.
September 24	Designated RSBC staff access the new workspace to support the transition. It is not the staff move-in date.
Week of September 28	Resident Week: resident workers begin working in the new space.
October 5–9	Drop-in Staff Week: staff without dedicated workspaces may begin working in the new space.

The steps you need to take depend on how you work in the Victoria office.

Resident workers with a dedicated workstation

If you are a resident worker at 940 Blanshard with a dedicated workstation:

- Begin decluttering and packing your workspace
- Pack your work and personal belongings by end of day September 17
- Clearly label your belongings for your new dedicated workstation at 620 Superior Street
- Attend the resident worker meeting during the week of September 8 for more information about the transition

Staff who work in the Victoria office occasionally

If you occasionally work in the Victoria office and do not have a dedicated workspace:

- Take all personal belongings home before September 17
- You will not need to pack up a dedicated workstation
- You may begin working from the new office during Drop-in Staff Week, October 5–9

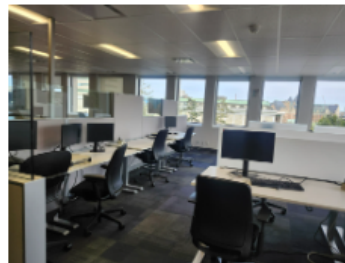
Tell me about our new location

RoadSafetyBC is moving to [620 Superior Street](#), located in downtown Victoria, with convenient access to nearby amenities, services and transit.

RoadSafetyBC will have dedicated workspace on the 5th floor, the top floor of the building. The floor will be shared with the Deputy Solicitor General's Office, Ministry GCPE staff, Corporate Strategic Initiatives, and Community Safety and Victim Services Branch Victoria staff.

The space was previously used by the Ministry of Education and Child Care and has been renovated to support flexible ways of working and collaboration.
